

Gum Turpentine

Description:

Gum Turpentine is a clear, water-white to light yellow volatile liquid with a distinct odor. It is derived from crude gum rosin dip upon further distillation.

Common uses are solvent applications such as fragrance additive, carrier fluid, paint thinning and cleaning. Alternative names are “spirits of turpentine”, “oil of turpentine”, and “wood turpentine”.
